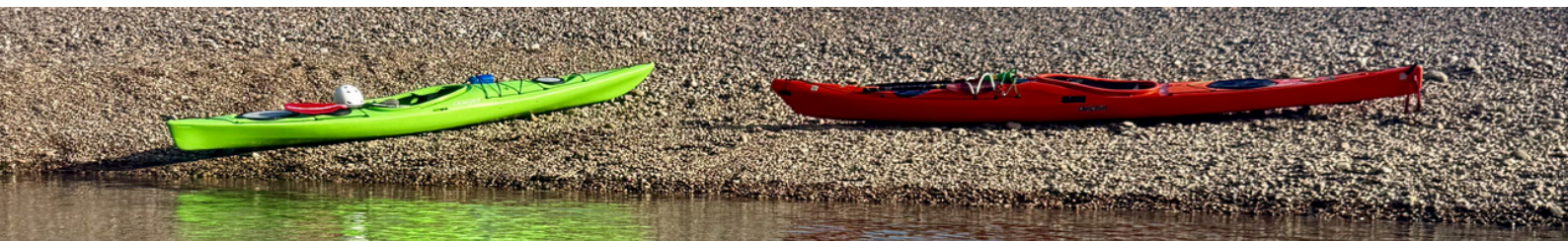

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CLUB SAFETY REMINDER

As we head into a busy summer, please take a moment to familiarise yourself with the club's fire safety procedures.

If you discover a fire, activate the nearest fire alarm call point immediately. **If the fire alarm sounds**, leave the clubhouse by the nearest safe exit (front or side door) and make your way to the assembly point on the Axe Yacht Club front patio. Please do not stop to collect personal belongings or re-enter the building until a club coach confirms it is safe to do so.

While you're at the club, please also help keep the site tidy. If you spot discarded water bottles around the grounds, either place them in the clubhouse bins or, if they're reusable, leave them on the sink in the clubhouse so they can be reunited with their owner.

Thank you for helping to keep AVCC safe and welcoming for everyone.

A gentle estuary paddle, perfect for all abilities with plenty of time to enjoy the scenery.

02/08/26 - Dartmouth Estuary & Coastline Explorer 10 miles

A full-day adventure exploring the estuary and coastline, with the option to visit the Mew Stone seal colony—plus a well-earned cream tea stop!

09/08/26 - Branscombe / Coast & Estuary Paddle (Short Trip) 6 miles

A relaxed ~6 mile paddle from the clubhouse, heading either along the coast towards Branscombe or Charton Bay, or up the estuary—route decided on the day to suit conditions. Perfect for an easy, enjoyable outing with great scenery.

A relaxed 10-mile round trip, ideal for building confidence and distance at a steady pace.
